I am Maria Lusitano, (b.Lisbon, 1971) living in London since 2011. My practice is research based and results mostly in installations that include work done in various media such as drawing, artist publications, collage, video (videoessay and artist film). My current art projects use experimental storytelling to explore "journeys of discovery" into invisible dimensions of expanded consciousness. They cover the themes of dreams, mysticism, and enlightenment. I also work with performance and artist films.

I concluded an MFA in Fine Art at Malmö Art Academy, Sweden in 2009. In 2015 I concluded my arts based Ph.D at the University of Westminster, London. My practice-based research was entitled (un)childhood, Performing the relational times and voices of childhood in the video-essay.

I have exhibited in international events such as Manifesta 5, Photo Espana 6, 29th Biennial of Sao Paulo, (2010) and others.
